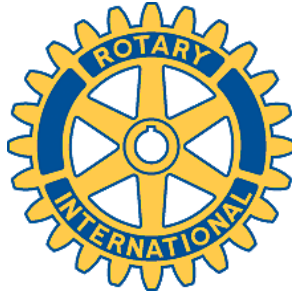


ROTARY ARTHUR N. BREWER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM 2011



This award is granted annually to a student or students who are judged to most closely fulfill the ideals of scholarship, school and community involvement and attitude toward life as exemplified by the life-long educator, Rotarian and founding president of the Castle Rock Rotary Club, Arthur N. Brewer. Applicants will be judged on their academic achievements, school and community service or involvement and by how they apply the Rotary Four-Way Test in their everyday lives. Financial need may be considered, but is not a prerequisite.

WHAT ROTARY IS:

Rotary is an international organization of local community service clubs. **The Object of Rotary** is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise. In other words, Rotarians around the world serve their community by using their work related talents to help others, both in the local community and throughout the world. For example, Castle Rock Rotarians raise money for the local Women's Crisis Center, the Senior Center, the Task Force, orphanages and impoverished communities in other parts of the world; sponsor the Rotary Youth Exchange Program; award scholarships and we built the Rock Park Shelter.

Rotarians are also committed to **high ethical standards**. That commitment is reflected in the Four Way Test. Rotarians promote the Object of Rotary by applying the Rotary Four Way Test to what we think, say and do. The Four Way Test is:

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR TO ALL CONCERNED?
3. Will it BUILD GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it BE BENEFICIAL TO ALL CONCERNED?
